

NEW ENGLAND COLLEGE RELOCATION POLICY AND PROCEDURE

New England College (NEC) is committed to ensuring that its programs and activities are readily accessible to disabled students, staff and faculty, and visitors. Where classes, programs, events, or activities are scheduled in inaccessible locations, upon a request for access NEC may provide accessibility through a variety of methods, including the use of ramps, relocation to an accessible location (where other methods of providing access are not feasible or practical), or employing auxiliary aids and services, technology, or equipment to make the event accessible. In choosing among these methods, NEC will give priority to methods that offer classes, programs, events, and activities to disabled participants in the most integrated setting appropriate.
